

# TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

20th January 2021

Visitors from any country who have been vaccinated can travel to the seychelles (Infants and children exempted).

Non vaccinated visitors from permitted countries are also allowed to travel to Seychelles under special conditions.



Visitors transiting through countries not on the permitted list (category 1) are allowed into Seychelles if they do not exit the airport during transit.

Visitors from non permitted countries who have stayed at least 14 days or more in a country on the permitted list (category 1) are permitted to enter into Seychelles.

Non vaccinated visitors from non-permitted countries travelling by private jets may also enter the Seychelles, subject to authorisation from the Seychelles Health Authority.

They will be limited to staying at certified island resorts or onboard super yachts only.

Non vaccinated visitors arriving by sea may also enter Seychelles subject to approval of the Seychelles Health Authority.

The vessel must spend at least 21 days at sea from its last port of call before entering Seychelles without a PCR test or they can come to shore after 10 days with a negative PCR test result

# ADVISORY FOR VACCINATED VISITORS

20th January 2021



**1.** Visitors can travel to Seychelles two weeks after taking the second dose of the vaccine. A valid vaccination certificate from their country's National Authority is required for entry.



**3.** Accommodation bookings must be made at licensed and certified establishments or liveboard only. Visit [www.tourism.gov.sc](http://www.tourism.gov.sc)



**5.** Vaccinated visitors are free to move around the islands, in strict adherence to applicable health measures i.e. wearing face masks in public and social distancing.

**4.** Health Travel Authorisation is required for entry through the platform: <https://seychelles.govtas.com/>. # ADVISORY FOR NON VACCINATED VISITORS



20th January 2021



**1.** All visitors incl. infants and children must have a negative PCR test certificate from an accredited laboratory, taken 72hrs before departure.



**2.** Accommodation bookings must be made at licensed and certified establishments or liveaboard only. Visitors must stay a maximum of 10 days at their first accommodation. Visit [www.tourism.gov.sc](http://www.tourism.gov.sc)



**5.** After the first ten days visitors are free to move around the islands, in strict adherence to applicable health measures i.e. wearing face masks in public and social distancing.



**3.** Health Travel Authorisation is required for entry through the platform: <https://seychelles.govtas.com/>. Application must include; booking vouchers for the entire stay in the destination, flights and PCR test. Visitors must also ensure they have valid travel insurance with full medical coverage including COVID-19-related medical care for their entire stay.



**4.** A surveillance PCR test will be administered on the sixth day and if the result is negative visitors can continue with their holiday.



**6.** Visitors wishing to take part in recreational activities such as tours, excursions, sightseeing etc must use licensed and certified tourism service providers. Visitors are not authorised to use public buses.
